Firstly, we are going to try and highlight a **Webinar a day** - something a little different that you might want to tap in to and/or try. Some of these Webinars are created by guests we were inviting to Dollar for the Post-Exam Programme, others by Dollar Teachers and Parents, and some that are hosted by Universities, Charities and a wide range of People from around the world:



Online Courses:

The range of online courses is growing. Please keep checking back on Firefly to see what is available. I would like to highlight two today, both with closing dates next week:



The first of these courses, **Defending Dignity: The Universal Declaration of Human Rights,** is an online course by **Amnesty International**. **Mrs Taylor** will lead participants through the course and conduct online discussion groups and debates as the course progresses. You must sign-up to this course by next **Wednesday 22 April**, via the online Form on Firefly, and then the course will begin on Mon 27 April 2020.

The second highlighted course, **Climate Solutions**, offers a simple and quick way to gain significant understanding of one of the most important issues of our generation: climate change. This course was originally designed for Business Leaders and Industry professionals, but is currently being developed for Individual Pre-University study. If you take on this course you will be one of the very first to complete this training. Pupils that complete the 4 modules will receive a certificate of completion endorsed by the University of Edinburgh, University of Stirling, the Royal Scottish Geographical Society and the Institute of Directors. Again, there is an online form to complete if you wish to take on this course, with a deadline of **24 April 2020**. **Mr Burbury** will lead participants through this course and conduct online discussion groups and debates as the course progresses.

Week 1 Challenge:

Thank you to those pupils that have already attempted the Bed-Time Story challenge. Keep these coming, we will keep accepting videos up until the end of next week.

Week 2 Challenge:
