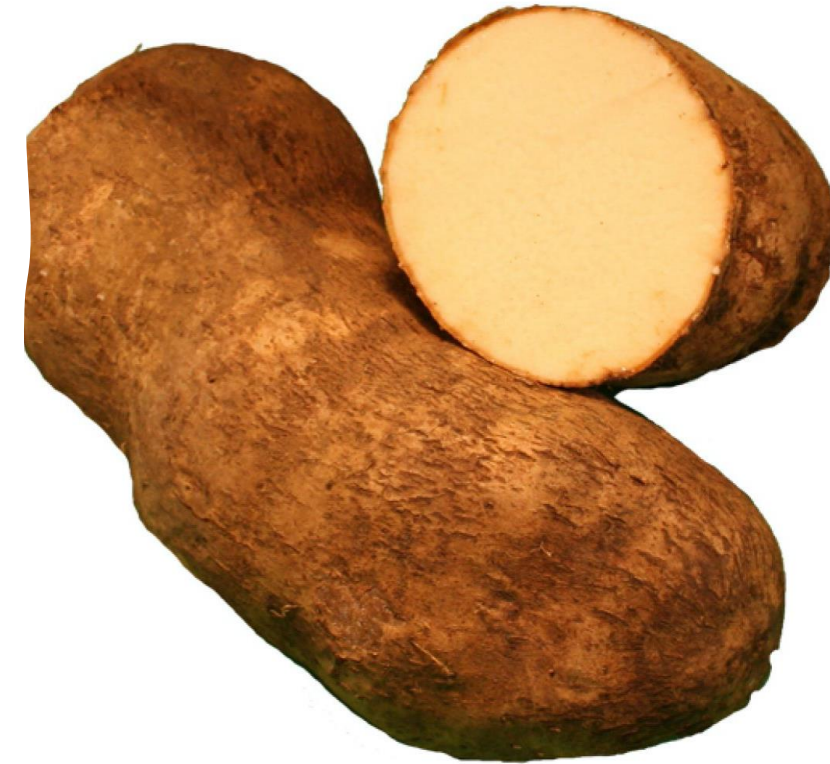
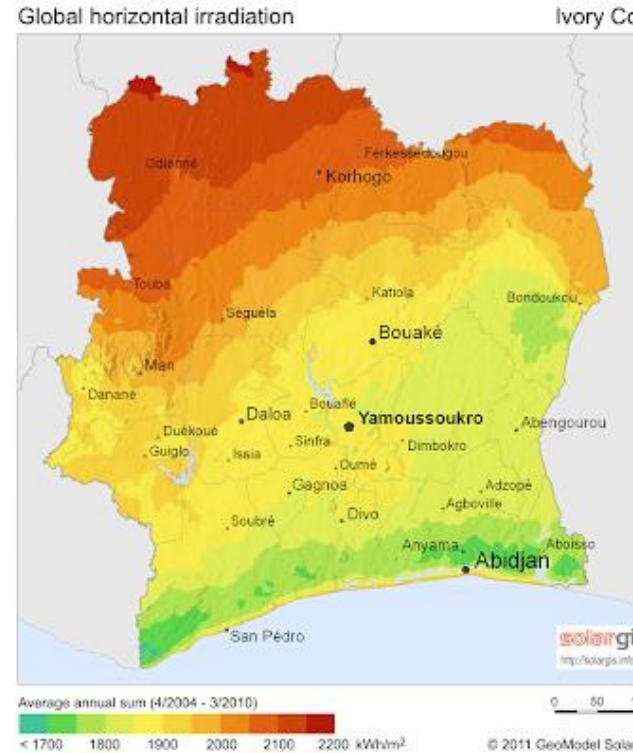
Geographical Information

- Highest Mountain: Mount Richard-Lumard



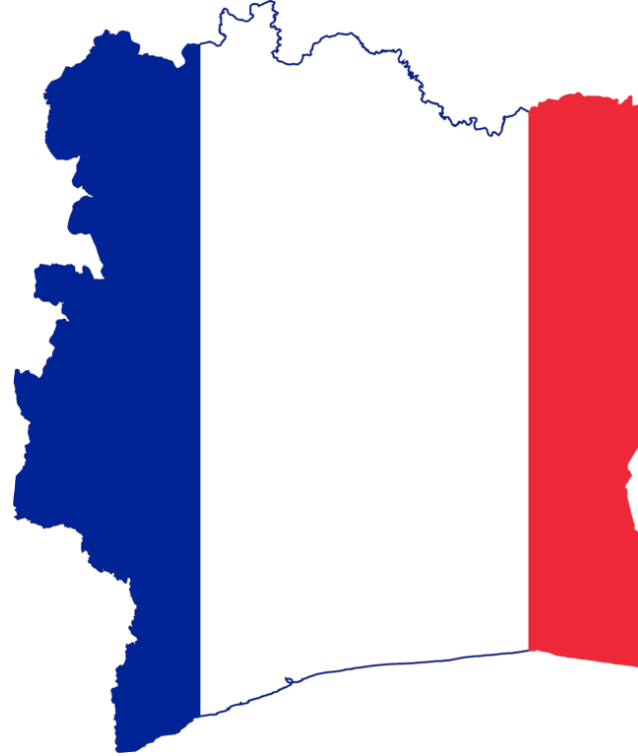

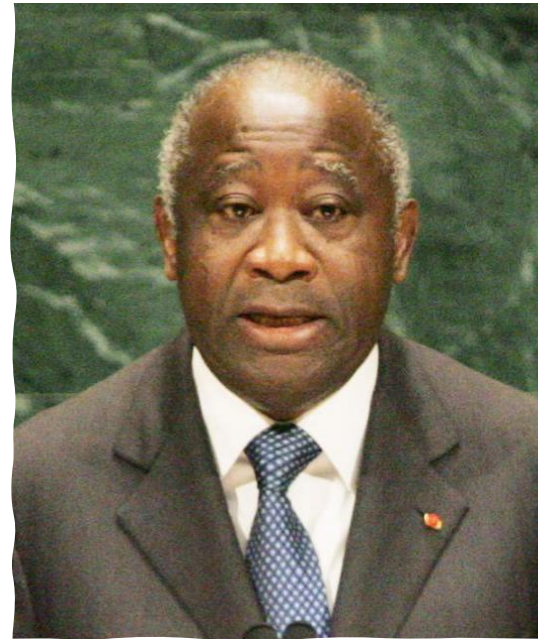


French colonisation – History
