

BREAK AND LUNCHTIMES (Dining Hall)

PREP AND JUNIOR PUPILS:

- All Prep and Junior children should bring a healthy snack for break, packed lunch and re-fillable water bottle.
- Lunch will take place in the classroom (or outside) supervised by the class teacher.
- Prep and Junior Pupils will not have any access to the dining hall or downtown.

SENIOR SCHOOL PUPILS

BREAK-TIME WILL BE STAGGERED

FI. II and III between P1 and P2 (10:10am)

FIV, V and VI between P2 and P3 (11:10am)

The Dining Hall will be open at break-time, serving the three most popular choices, bacon/sausage rolls and pizza. There will be three serving locations and a one-way system to be followed. Food will only be available to takeaway and will be paid for via our fingerprint system as per usual. Pupils will be asked to sanitise their hands before and after use. There will be sanitising stations at every station and at the entrance to the dining hall.

LUNCH

Senior Pupils in FII – VI, taking part in a lunch-time co-curricular activity should bring a packed lunch, and eat at their club/activity.

For Senior school pupils, access to the dining hall will be limited, as follows:

The Dining Hall will offer three hot options and three cold options. The Dining Hall menu from 21 August – 11 September on website <u>here</u>

- Hot options will be served in Dining Hall.
- Cold options will be distributed in the Senior Marquee.

All of Form I will still be required to eat their lunch in the dining hall. Their lunch-time will begin at 12:15pm

Access to the dining hall (for hot meals) and the marquee (for cold meals) will be staggered as follows:

12:15pm	Form I
12:30pm	Form II
12:40pm	Form III
12:50pm	Form IV
1:00pm	Form V
1:10pm	Form VI

There will be limited capacity for hot meals to be eaten in the dining hall. 2 of the 3 hot meals offered, will be able to be taken away.

Pupils will be encouraged to eat outside where possible (except FI who will eat together in the dining hall). However, on wet weather days pupils will be able to eat inside as follows:

Form II and III: Assembly Hall 12:30pm – 12:55pm

Form IV and V: Assembly Hall 1:00pm - 1:25pm

Form VI: Form VI Centre and Senior Marquee
